AAJ Ambassador Program

Former AAJ President David Casey founded the AAJ Ambassador program to assure that every law school in the U.S. has at least one trial lawyer representative to interact with law students on campus and to spread the word about trial law and about AAJ. Make an investment in the future of AAJ by becoming an AAJ Ambassador. As an AAJ Ambassador, you can provide information to law students about how trial lawyers contribute to society. They will benefit greatly by their contact with you.

AAJ Ambassadors have agreed to the following:

- With AAJ staff support, form a law student chapter of AAJ (if one doesn't already exist)
- Meet with the AAJ chapter president
- Speak at least once per year to the AAJ chapter on a topic such as "What Is It Like To Be A Trial Lawyer" or "Why I am A Trial Lawyer" or another topic selected in conjunction with the chapter president
- Facilitate mentoring opportunities, which may include talking with a group of students or appointing a mentor from your firm.

Most of the logistics, such as setting up a meeting with the chapter president or arranging the scheduling of presentations to students, will be handled by AAJ staff. Your responsibility as an AAJ Ambassador will be to tell students about the work you do, and either directly or indirectly facilitates mentoring opportunities.
