7. I will not disclose information of a strategic nature to non-members if such disclosure would compromise the interests of members and their clients who are victims of acetaminophen injuries.
8. I will not share, show, reveal, or disclose any information, documents, index, or materials obtained from the Acetaminophen Injury Litigation Group, its members, or the AAJ Exchange, nor will I distribute the information unless ordered to do so by a court of competent jurisdiction.
9. I will notify the Chair or Cochairs of the Acetaminophen Injury Litigation Group if any request is made to obtain the Index or any materials obtained from or through the Acetaminophen Injury Litigation Group, and I will resist such attempts.
10. I understand that there will be a dues obligation to the Litigation Group, initially \$200 for the first member of a firm, and \$100 for an unlimited number of subsequent members from the same firm with no firm paying more than \$300, but subject to reasonably necessary increases from time to time.
