6. I will fully and candidly share relevant information, documents, and other materials with other members of the Daily Fantasy Sports Litigation Group.
7. I will not disclose information of a strategic nature to non-members if such disclosure would compromise the interests of members and their clients who are victims of daily fantasy sports.
8. I will not share, show, reveal, or disclose any information, documents, index, or materials obtained from the Daily Fantasy Sports Litigation Group, its members, or the AAJ Exchange, nor will I distribute the information unless ordered to do so by a court of competent jurisdiction.
9. I will notify the Chair(s) of the Daily Fantasy Sports Litigation Group if any request is made to obtain the Index or any materials obtained from or through Daily Fantasy Sports Litigation Group, and I will resist such attempts.
10. I agree to take the necessary and appropriate action to resist the entrance of a Restrictive Protective Order which forbids or unreasonably restricts the sharing of discovery materials between and among the members of this Group and other attorneys attempting to work together in a common effort to properly prepare cases which involve daily fantasy sports.
11. I understand that there will be an annual dues obligation to the Litigation Group of \$100 per member, but subject to reasonably necessary increases from time to time.

I understand that my initial and continued membership in this Litigation Group is contingent upon the payment of dues, membership in AAJ, membership in good standing of the Bar, and my ongoing commitment to the principles and representations made above on which I fully appreciate that my colleagues are strictly relying.
