8. I will fully and candidly share relevant information, documents, and other materials with other members of the Hernia Mesh Litigation Group.
9. I will not disclose information of a strategic nature to non-members if such disclosure would compromise the interests of members and their clients who are victims of Hernia Mesh products.
10. I will not share, show, reveal, or disclose any information, documents, index, or materials obtained from the Hernia Mesh Litigation Group, its members, or the AAJ Exchange, nor will I distribute the information unless ordered to do so by a court of competent jurisdiction.
