1. I make this affidavit on personal knowledge and in support of my application for membership in the AAJ Inadequate Security Litigation Group.

6. I will maintain the confidentiality of all materials I obtain from the AAJ Inadequate Security Litigation Group or any of its members.

I will resist any defense requests for secrecy orders or confidentiality orders which would prohibit the sharing of information between me and members of the Inadequate Security Litigation Group and/or restrict access to information needed by other victims of inadequate security; however, I will abide by any proper order of the court, including any secrecy or protective orders.

I agree that any documents provided to me by the Inadequate Security Litigation Group are and will remain the property of the Inadequate Security Litigation Group at all times, and I will return them to the Inadequate Security Litigation Group upon the completion of my case, or when requested to do so by the Inadequate Security Litigation Group. In the event that I need to make any photocopies of Inadequate Security Litigation Group documents, any such photocopies will also be the property of the Inadequate Security Litigation Group. I will return all Inadequate Security Litigation Group documents, and any photocopies thereof, immediately upon request by the Inadequate Security Litigation Group. In the event I wish to use any document provided to me by the Inadequate Security Litigation Group in the conduct of discovery of my case, or for use at trial, I shall first make every effort to obtain a copy of the document from its original source. If I am not able to, however, I agree to seek permission from the Inadequate Security Litigation Group prior to using any such document in discovery or at trial. In the event that I receive any discovery request that could cover any documents provided to me by the Inadequate Security Litigation Group, I agree that I will return such documents to Inadequate Security Litigation Group and any photocopies thereof, and will not produce said property of the Inadequate Security Litigation Group to any defendants or defense attorneys.

In the event a defendant seeks production of any material obtained by me from the Inadequate Security Litigation Group, I shall notify the Inadequate Security Litigation Group of such request and shall provide the Inadequate Security Litigation Group sufficient notice to allow it to appear in opposition to any motion by a defendant to produce such material.
10. The foregoing representations and assurances are made with my full knowledge that the Inadequate Security Litigation Group and its members will rely upon them.
