Neither I, nor anyone from my firm or anyone affiliated with my firm, defends or otherwise represents (including all forms of transactional work) any taxi provider or ride sharing company any organization or group that represents the interest of taxi provider or ride sharing company or other similar companies.
3. Neither my practice nor my firm's practice, in whole or meaningful part, has a significant relationship with interests adverse to, on inconsistent to, those of AAJ or the Ride Share Litigation Group.
4. I desire to work in concert with other member attorneys representing plaintiffs in similar ride share cases in cooperative effort to assist in achieving our common interests to prepare and fairly resolve individual cases properly.
5. I will not disclose any portion of, or any copies of, any information obtained from this Group to any company involved with Ride Share or affiliate entity, their agents, employees, independent contractors, or to any person, firm or entity where the materials may be seen, copied, accessed, or otherwise reached by any ride share related entity or person or affiliated entities.
6. I will not make recordings of any Ride Share Litigation Group meetings or proceedings or any portion thereof without the written permission of the Chair or Cochairs.
7. I will fully and candidly share relevant information, documents, and other materials with other members of the Ride Share Litigation Group.
8. I will not disclose information of a strategic nature to non-members if such disclosure would compromise the interests of members and their clients who are victims of ride share companies.
9. I will not share, show, reveal, or disclose any information, documents, index, or materials obtained from the Ride Share Litigation Group, its members, or the AAJ Exchange, nor will I distribute the information unless ordered to do so by a court of competent jurisdiction.
10. I will notify the Chair or Cochairs of the Ride Share Litigation Group if any request is made to obtain the Index or any materials obtained from or through Ride Share Litigation Group, and I will resist such attempts.
11. I understand that there will be an annual dues obligation to the Litigation Group, initially \$100, but subject to reasonably necessary increases from time to time.
12. I understand that my initial and continued membership in this Litigation Group is contingent upon the payment of dues, membership in AAJ, membership in good standing of the Bar, and my ongoing commitment to the principles and representations made above on which I fully appreciate that my colleagues are strictly relying.

I understand that I am not entitled as a matter of right to be a member of this Litigation Group nor do I have any obligation to join, and that I will be entitled to remain in this Group only to the extent that I fully comply with the above written representations and subject to the prevailing rules, regulations, and guidelines for AAJ Litigation Groups in general and the Ride Share Litigation Group in particular.
