9. I will notify the Chairperson of the Risperdal Litigation Group if an effort is made by motion, subpoena, request for production, or other means to obtain material I have obtained from the Risperdal Litigation Group.

I acknowledge a mutuality of interest with other members of the Risperdal Litigation Group, and I intend for exchanges of information among us of documents useful to plaintiffs in prosecuting Risperdal cases are to be treated as creating and sharing of a common work product, protected from disclosure by the work product doctrine, and, to the extent applicable, by the attorney client privilege, and that this mutuality of interest is not tied to the resolution of any particular claim or lawsuit, but rather will continue for as long as any among us has litigation in progress or under consideration.
